

Projects Carried by the Community Action Groups in the year 2009 – 2010

In the Kingsforest area the following projects have been completed:-

- A lamp post has been connected to the site at Siston CI in Kingswood,
- A metal gate has been installed between 41 & 42 Siston Park in Kingswood,
- New fence panels have been erected at Alanscourt in Warmley,
- Handrails have been installed from the communal lounge to the garden at Plowright House, Hanham,
- A second handrail has been installed to the rear stairs & St Barnabas House, Warmley & a sign has been move
- A grit bin has been installed at Park Rd flats in Kingswood.
- A donation has been made to the Guys & Dolls over 50's club in Cadbury Heath to help them set up.
- A garden vacuum has also been bought for St Barnabas House, Warmley.

The following projects have been agreed, but not yet started:-

- Key klamps, to the front of Abraham Fry House in Kingswood,
- New steps to prevent slipping at Abraham Fry House, Kingswood
- Chain link fencing at Abraham Fry House
- A donation to the suburbs church in Cadbury Heath, which is used by Kingsforest Community Action Group & the Guys & Dolls club, towards refurbishment works

In the Severn View area the following project has been completed:-

- Provision of funding towards bicycles for the Patchway Police Beat team
- Patchway youth photography project.

In the One Voice area the following projects have been agreed but not yet started:-

- Storage at Hayfield flats in Marshfield
- 2 washing lines to Beezer Close flats in Staple Hill
- 2 lockable gates to secure the garden area in Beezer Close, Staple Hill
- Yellow markings in the car parking area at Staple Hill flats
- Installation of 7 concrete bollards to prevent inconsiderate parking, in particular around the grassed area at Staple Hill flats
- 3 rows of shrubs to be planted at Walker Court to prevent youths playing football in the grounds.

The following projects are currently under consideration by the Community Action groups:-

In the Kingsforest Area:-

- Provision of washing lines for the flats at Park Road, Kingswood
- Wood staining of the new fence at Alanscourt in Warmley

In the Severn View area:-

- Parking Lines at Langdale Court, Patchway
- Parking Lines, Streamleaze , Thornbury
- Drying area at Alveston
- Bollards at Thames House, Thornbury

In the One Voice area:-

- Community events/groups in Marshfield

In the Frome Valley area

- Removal of the fish pond at Kennedy House in Yate & landscape the area
- A ramp at the rear of the building, removal of trees & replace the benches & fences at Beaufort Rd in Yate
- Frampton Cottrell – To provide a bench on the green
- Fence to front of two bungalows on Hounds Road, Chipping Sodbury
- Removal of shrubs and place turf at Cranleigh Court Road Bungalows, Yate
- Provision of two ramps for the Homefield community Building in Pucklechurch

In the Filton & District area:-

- Repairs to 2 benches at Neate Court, Little Stoke
- Installation of a guide bar and ramp into communal gardens at Neate Court, Little Stoke
- Communal vandal proof bench overlooking open space behind 95-97 Little Stoke Lane, Little Stoke
- Metal gate, additional security gate and fencing panels at Cleve Court, Filton
- Replacement of rotary lines at Church View, Filton
- Re-modelling of bin area to include concrete ramp and side entry to bin store at Newleaze House, Filton
- Internal signage at Newleaze House, Filton
